

# Update of Districts' 2023 Operations

## **2023 Plan of Operations**

The Districts have not yet agreed to an AOP for the 2023 Water Year.

During the non-irrigation season, the Districts met or exceeded Central's release requirements for the Keystone Canal and Central's Diversion Dam.

During the irrigation season, the Districts will only release storage water to meet irrigation demand.

Since the Districts have not yet agreed to an AOP, no irrigations season projections have been made yet.

## **Maintenance**

NPPD is planning a maintenance outage to work on various projects. We plan to start outage work mid to late September. Coordinating with Central to maintain one black-start resource between Kingsley and North Platte Hydro will determine the extent of the outage. Lining/concrete across various spots of the canal are expected, inspecting Sutherland Outlet, and depending on blackstart capability will determine if inspections can take place on Maloney outlet gate and forebay. Other projects are assumed to arise as inspections take place.

Central will coordinate a Kingsley outage with NPPD's planned outage in the fall. Central also plans to have one week hydro outages for Jeffrey, Johnson No. 1 and Johnson No. 2 hydros from late September through November. The Supply Canal outages (Jeffrey, Johnson No. 1, and Johnson No. 2) should not affect FERC flow requirements.
